

## ORGANIZATIONAL AND ECONOMIC ASPECT OF LABOR PROTECTION SPECIALIST PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCE FORMATION

One of the reasons for socio-economic losses from unfavourable work conditions is the low labor protection specialists' professional competence level.
